The weather during August

After a period of cool, unsettled weather during the first fortnight, conditions improved considerably in the second half of the month during which there was little or no rain, daytime temperatures were well up to or above normal August levels and most places enjoyed good sunny periods. Most crops made good progress and harvesting of the earliest cereals got under way under generally favourable weather conditions during the last ten days although morning fog caused some delays in places.

Rainfall during the month was below normal everywhere except in some areas in the extreme north; in Malin Head, total rainfall for the month was 85.4 millimetres (104% of normal) but of this total nearly 40% fell on one day (8th). In most inland districts, rainfall was less than 70% of normal and in some places in the Dublin area rainfall over the month was less than 30% of the normal August total. The period 13th - 31st was almost completely dry everywhere and soil moisture levels which had remained high throughout most of the Summer were greatly reduced during this dry spell.

Although daytime temperatures were above normal for most of the second half of the month, these were more than balanced by low night temperatures throughout the month and below-average day temperatures during the first fortnight. Mean air temperatures over the month as a whole were thus below average everywhere; deviations from normal ranged from -0.9°C at Dublin Airport to -1.8°C at Cahirciveen. Totals of degree-days above 10°C accumulated over the month were about 20% lower than the average of the August totals over the past ten years; degree-day totals over the May-August period this year were only 75% - 80% of the 1962-1971 averages for the same period. Consequently, crops such as maize and sugar-beet which have a high heat requirement were still quite backward at the end of the month; the ultimate yields of these crops will be largely dependent on temperatures during the remainder of the growing season.
