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- Ventilators:
 - Stocks are sufficient to supply anticipated surge requirements.
 - Further deliveries are not required.
- Infusion pumps:
 - Stocks exceed target based on anticipated surge requirements.
- Syringe drivers:
 - Stocks are sufficient to supply anticipated surge requirements.
 - All hospitals remain fully serviced.
- PPE: Supply of stocks remains strong.
- HSE continues to monitor ICU surge capacity; this will be reviewed on an ongoing basis in response to Covid-19 case numbers and trends.
- Next meeting TBC. Agreed that this group will no longer meet to discuss Covid-19 issues exclusively. This is consistent with NPHE policy of standing down a number of its subgroups. However, the Brexit Criticality Assessment Group is likely to be reformed in the coming weeks, and Covid-19 supply issues can be considered as part of the Brexit group's discussions, if necessary.
